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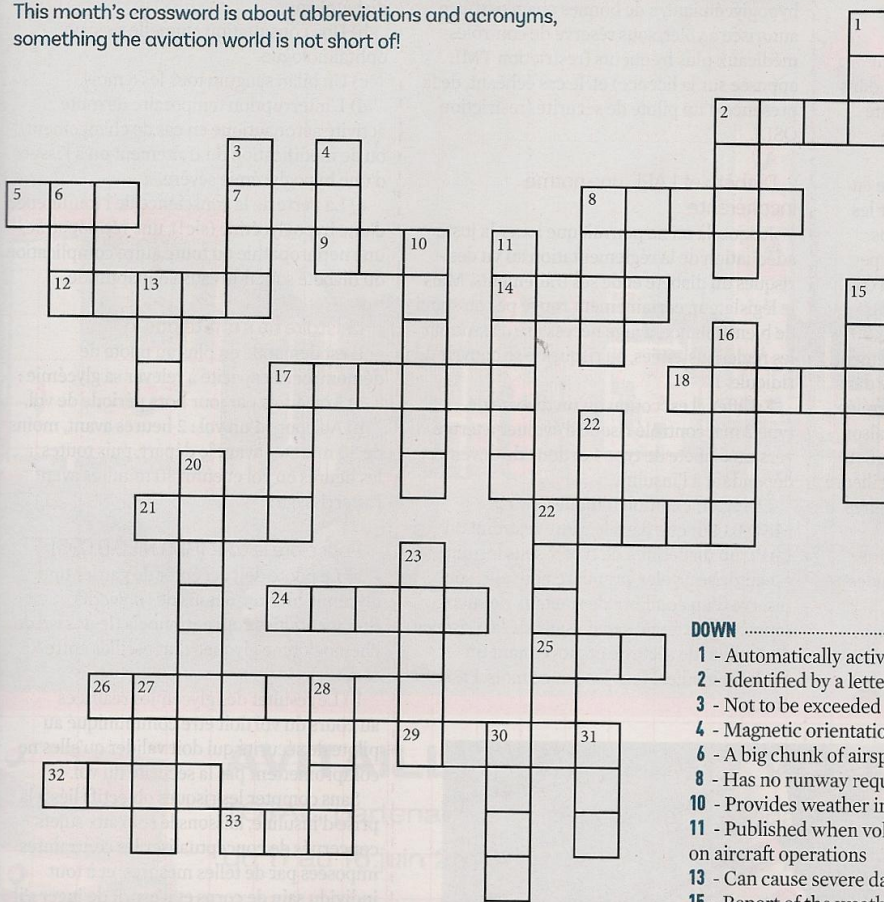

- 1 - Automatically activated by impact

- 11 - Published when volcanic activity can have an impact on aircraft operations

- 17 - European regulation
- 19 - Teaches you how to fly
- 20 - Their handling is highly regulated
- 22 - This agency's reports are of interest to airports local residents
